Types:

Past simple → Subject + past simple*

<u>Affirmative</u>	<u>Negative</u>	<u>Interrogative</u>
I play <mark>ed</mark>	l didn't play	Did I play?
He spoke	He didn't work	Did he work?
We sang	We didn't sing	Did we sing?



*past simple = 2nd column (irregular verbs) or -ed ending (regular verbs)

Past continuous ——> Subject + was/were + verb (+ ing) 2

<u>Affirmative</u> **Negative** <u>Interrogative</u> I was playing I wasn't playing Was I playing? He was working He wasn't working Was he working? We were singing We weren't singing Were we singing?

3 Past perfect simple Subject + had + past participle*

<u>Affirmative</u>	<u>Negative</u>	<u>Interrogative</u>
I had play <mark>ed</mark>	I hadn't play <mark>ed</mark>	Had I played?
He had bought	He hadn't bought	Had he bought?
We had sung	We hadn't sung	Had we sung?





*past participle = 3rd column (irregular verbs) or -ed ending (regular verbs)

4 Past perfect continuous ——> Subject + had + been + verb (+ ing)

<u>Affirmative</u>	<u>Negative</u>
I had been playing	I hadn't <mark>be</mark>

I had been playing He had been working We had been singing I hadn't been playing He hadn't been working We hadn't been singing

Interrogative

Had I been playing? Had he been working? Had we been singing?
